ITINERARY

JULY 14 DEPART NEWARK.

MON Board British Airways 188 in Newark at 9:00pm bound for London.

JULY 15 ARRIVE LONDON.

TUES Arrive into London's Heathrow Airport at 9:10A.

You are met by your local English-speaking guide upon arrival and assisted to the motorcoach. Transfer from the airport to your hotel.

Please note that rooms may not be ready for check-in until early afternoon, however, the hotel will hold your luggage.

Lunch is on your own. The balance of the day is at leisure.

Dinner is included at your hotel.

JULY 16 LONDON.

WED Continental breakfast at the hotel.

After breakfast board your motorcoach for a trip to Bunhill Fields, the Dissenters burial ground for the graves including Fox, Bunyan and Daniel Dafoe.

Lunch is included at a local restaurant, followed by a guided sightseeing tour of the Old City of London. Visits include the Tower of London and St. Paul's Cathedral.

Dinner is included at your hotel.

JULY 17 LONDON / STRATFORD.

THUR Continental breakfast at the hotel.

Depart London today, with visits to Jordans, the Mayflower Barn and the graves of the Penns and the Peningtons en route.

A packed lunch is included.

Continue to your hotel in Stratford for check-in, where you have some free time upon arrival.

Dinner is included at your hotel.

An evening performance at the Royal Shakespeare Theatre is planned. Return to your hotel afterwards.

JULY 18 STRATFORD / BIRMINGHAM / STRATFORD.

FRI Full English breakfast at the hotel.

Begin your day with a visit to Shakespeare's Birthplace, followed by some free time to stroll around on your own.

Travel to Birmingham, where a tour of the area is scheduled.

Lunch is included at Woodbrooke.

This afternoon proceed to the Bournville Village Trust Estate. A visit to Cadbury World is also included. Return to your hotel in Stratford for overnight.

Dinner is on your own tonight.

JULY 19 STRATFORD / COVENTRY / STRATFORD.

SAT Full English breakfast at the hotel.

This morning's visits include Fenny Drayton, Mancetter and Hartshill. Talk at Hartshill about Warwickshire Quakers.

A packed lunch is provided.

Proceed to Coventry for your visit to Coventry Cathedral, including the Visitor's Centre audio-visual presentation. Schedule permitting, more visits are planned for this afternoon. Return to your hotel in Stratford.

Dinner is included at your hotel.

JULY 20 STRATFORD / SHREWSBURY.

SUN Full English breakfast at the hotel.

You have time for Worship this morning.

Afterwards depart Stratford for your full day tour to Coalbrookdale and the Ironbridge Gorge World Heritage site. Arrive at Ironbridge Heritage Centre to visit the Darby Furnace and Rosehill House before going on to the Museum of the River in Coalbrookdale and the Iron Bridge.

Lunch is included at a local restaurant today.

Continue your Ironbridge visit, including the Blists Hill Open Air Museum. Afterwards check-in to your hotel in Shrewsbury.

Dinner is included at your hotel.

JULY 21 SHREWSBURY / LANCASTER.

MON Full English breakfast at the hotel.

After breakfast board the motorcoach and depart for visits to Rossendale, Pendle Hill and the Forest of Bowland.

Packed lunches are provided.

Continue to your hotel in Lancaster.

Dinner is included at your hotel.

JULY 22 LANCASTER / MORECAMBE BAY / KENDAL / LANCASTER.

TUES Full English breakfast at the hotel.

Today take a full-day excursion around Morecambe Bay to Swarthmoor Hall, stopping at Cartmel en route.

A packed lunch is provided.

A visit to The Quaker Tapestry in Kendal is planned for this afternoon. Return to your hotel in Lancaster.

Dinner is included at your hotel.

JULY 23 LANCASTER.

WED Full English breakfast at the hotel.

After breakfast visit Lancaster Castle followed by a drive out to Brigflatts.

A packed lunch is included.

Continue on to visit Firbank Fell, where minibuses transfer you to the top. You have some time at leisure before the minibuses return you to your motorcoach.

Travel back to your hotel in Lancaster.

Dinner is included at your hotel.

JULY 24 LANCASTER / YORK.

THUR Full English breakfast at the hotel.

Depart for York.

Lunch is included at your hotel in York.

This afternoon's sightseeing includes the Retreat and Quaker Mental Hospital.

Dinner included at your hotel this evening.

FRI Full English breakfast at the hotel.

After breakfast take a guided tour of York, including the Minster.

Lunch is included at a nearby restaurant afterwards.

The remainder of the day is free for shopping and individual pursuits.

JULY 26 YORK / NORWICH.

SAT Full English breakfast at the hotel.

This morning depart for Norwich.

Lunch is included at a restaurant en route.

Check in to your hotel in Norwich upon arrival.

Dinner is included at your hotel tonight.

JULY 27 NORWICH.

SUN Full English breakfast at the hotel.

This morning is at leisure for Worship.

Lunch included at a local restaurant.

This afternoon meet your local guide for a city sightseeing tour of Norwich, including visits to Norwich Cathedral, Mother Julian's Cell. A guided tour of Earlham Hall is also included.

Dinner is included at your hotel tonight.

JULY 28 NORWICH / LONDON.

MON Full English breakfast at the hotel.

Return to London today where the final day of your tour is free for individual pursuits.

Tonight enjoy your final dinner together at the hotel followed by a show in London's West End. Roundtrip transfers included..

TUES Continental breakfast at the hotel.

You are met by your local guide at the hotel this morning and transferred to Heathrow Airport.

HOTEL DESCRIPTIONS

LONDON / RADISSON VANDERBILT HOTEL (68-86 Cromwell Road) - First class, modernized Victorian hotel located in South Kensington, near the Royal Albert Hall, Hyde Park, Harrod's and Gloucester Road tube station. 224 rooms with private bath/shower, hair dryer, trouser press, color TV, radio, tea/coffee maker and phone. The hotel has 24-hour room service, restaurant, lounge and bar.

STRATFORD / CHARLECOTE PHEASANT HOTEL (Charlecote) - Moderate first class small hotel located in a rural setting, 4 miles from the center of Stratford-upon-Avon and 15 miles from Cadbury World. 70 rooms with private bath/shower, hair dryer, phone, radio, color TV, trouser press and tea/coffee maker. The hotel has a 24-hour room service, restaurant, bar, lounge, heated pool and 2 tennis courts.

SHREWSBURY / ALBRIGHTON HALL HOTEL (Albrighton, Shrewsbury. Shropshire) - First class hotel, which is housed in 17th-century manor house, featuring traditional Old World elegance combined with modern comfort. 71 rooms with private bath/shower, robe, radio, and cable TV. The hotel has limited room service, restaurant, lounge, coffee shop, fitness center, concierge, swimming pool and squash court.

LANCASTER / ROYAL KINGS ARMS HOTEL (75 Market Street) - Moderate first class, attractive 17th-century hotel; situated in the heart of Lancaster. 55 rooms with private bath/shower, hair dryer, trouser press, phone, radio and satellite color TV. The hotel has 24-hour room service, restaurant, 2 bars and lounge.

YORK / MOAT HOUSE HOTEL (North Street) - First class hotel overlooking York Minster, on opposite bank of River Ouse. 200 rooms with private bath/shower, hair dryer, phone, radio, satellite TV and tea/coffee maker. The hotel has a restaurant, 2 bars and fitness center.

NORWICH / MAID'S HEAD HOTEL (Tombland) - Charming, moderate first class hotel on the outskirts of town. 45 rooms, some with adjoining cottage, with private bath, phone, radio, color TV and tea/coffee maker. The hotel has a restaurant and bar.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE.

1. A deposit in the amount of \$500.00 per person is due in our office upon registration of the passengers.
2. No penalties at all for individual cancellations until May 12, 2003. From May 13 onward, a \$100 per person cancellation penalty will apply in addition to any non-recoverable fees (e.g. theatre tickets).
3. FINAL PAYMENT. Final payment is due by May 12, 2003.
